

# DAY 1 Arrival in Cagliari and transfer to Osini

Arrival at Cagliariairport, the capital of Sardinia. Organized transfer (duration about 1h20) or independent arrival to Osini. You will be welcomed on site by our team who will explain your trip itinerary and make sure your electric bike is well adjusted. For this 1st try, we recommend that you take the scenic road that leads to the Lequarci waterfalls and the 16th century church dedicated to Saint Barbara.



### DAY 2 Osini - Sadali

High peaks, holm oak forests, and superb panoramas will accompany you on this day. You will start by riding through the picturesque mountain village with its open-air museum, admiring the works of Maria Lai and other internationally renowned artists. Cross the old railway line with a beautiful view of the Pardu valley and arrive at the small hamlet of Gairo Tacquisara nestled in the limestone mountains. You will cross the village of Ussassai before arriving at Seui. Seui is a village rich in history and culture located between Ogliastra and Barbagia, where you can visit the old Spanish prisons and the Museum of Rural Culture. Continue your ride to the village of Sadali, the water village, where you will be fascinated by its narrow streets, the characteristic stone houses and the small waterfall of S. Valentino in the heart of the old town. A warm welcome awaits you from your host who will show you the village's sensory museum and give you an explanation of the medicinal plants.





DAY 3

### From Sadali to Villagrande Strisaili

Today you are about to explore the country roads of the Gennargentu National Park. Looking north you can see Punta La Marmora, the highest peak in Sardinia. Ride along the rim of the Flumendosa lake till Villagrande Strisaili, One of the few villages to be part of Sardinia's Blue Zone.

### DAY 4

### From Villagrande Strisaili to S.Maria Navarrese

From the village of the centenarians, reach the lake of S. Lucia. Continuing in bucolic country roads you will reach the town of Triei then Arrive to Santa Maria Navarrese, which owes its name, according to legend, to a spanish princess of Navarra who shipwrecked with her ship in these places.

### **DAY 5**Santa Maria Navarrese

Today is a free day with a lot of options! For example, you could enjoy the beach, hike along the coastal path to Perda longain about 3 hours or simply discover the surroundings. We recommend a boat trip to the Gulf of Orosei to

visit the stunning coves (to be booked on site). It is also possible to cycle to meet shepherds in Urzulei or Baunei and to discover their livelihoods. Participate in milking goats or making cheese and of course, you will have lunch with them. In the evening go for an "aperitivo" at one of the bars facing the sea!

### DAY 6

### Santa Maria Navarrese Cardedu

Today you can really delight in the beauty of the coastal surroundings and in the variety of landscapes: cycle in front of the white sandy beach of Lido di Orrì and the

red stones of the bay of Cea. Cross the Teccu plateau to reach Barisardo where you can visit the old Aragonese tower built on the beach to defend the population from Arab invasions. Pedal your way over to Cardedu, where long white beaches and crystal blue waters await you. In the evening you are welcomed for dinner by Maria from the farmhouse. If you wish, you may learn to make the famous Sardinian pasta (culurgiornes) over a glass of wine, to be enjoyed with moderation!







### **DAY 7**Cardedu - Ulassai

Today's route begins with the ascent of the Rio Pardu schist valley (a Natural Monument of Sardinia); a road winding its way through green hills, covered

with olive trees and rows of vines from which the famous Cannonau wine was born. It seems that this wine is the secret of the longevity of the region's inhabitants. Finally, you will arrive in Ulassai where we suggest you visit the laboratory of the textile cooperative. Choose to visit the famous Su Marmuri Caves or the museum of modern Art with the artist Maria Lai.

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### DAY 8 Departure

> The rolling hills and the vineyards

of Jerzu (tasting optional)

Early morning start from Ulassai to reach Cagliari airport (transfer time 1h20). It is advisable to take a flight after 11h00 to ensure you have time for the transfer.

- The assistance provided (telephone assistance during the day in case of problems)
- Supply of a roadbook

- Intervention to repair bicycles (from 90€) every day
- Transfer in the case of tiredness (service to be paid on site directly to the operator)

- Lunches (you decide on your meal according to where you want to stop)
